

2021 Biomedical Career Advancement Program (BCAP) FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Who can apply to BCAP 2021?

High school students (grades 10-12) are eligible to apply for BCAP (students from Wayne County will be given priority consideration)

What are the application requirements?

Students must submit an online application; additional required components of a complete submission include:

- ☐ Personal Career Goals Statement (400-500 words)
- ☐ GPA ≥ 3.0 (transcripts will be required upon acceptance to the program)

May I pick up a hard copy of the application?

No, the entire application must be completed and submitted online. Visit https://miahec.wayne.edu/southeast/highschool to start your application.

How do I apply?

Students are required to submit a complete online application.

What should be included in my personal career goals statement?

This statement should describe your career interests and goals in biomedical science or scientific research; additionally, the statement should include type(s) of degree(s) you wish to pursue. Additionally, consider including how specific people, experiences and your personal background have influenced your personal development and interest in science. Highlight any hardships that you have had to overcome. Your statement should be 400 to 500 words.

Can I participate in BCAP along with other activities in the summer (e.g. employment/educational programs)?

Students may not take academic classes nor be engaged in other activities that would prevent them from attending all training sessions and adhering to a regular daytime work schedule. Students who accept a position with BCAP <u>must</u> be able to commit to an assignment schedule of approximately 25-30 hours per week.

What kind of technology is needed to participate?

Students will need an internet-connected laptop, Chromebook or desktop computer equipped with a webcam. If there are any technology barriers, it will be addressed upon the student's program acceptance.
